Lisa Gigliotti is a successful attorney and appointed member of the Michigan Prescription Drug and Opioid Commission. Her testimony and story of courage will instill a message of motivation for nurse practitioners to continue to positively impact their patients and overcome adversity in their personal and professional lives. Her seat at the policy-making table, along with the daily companion of pain, will bring a unique and up-to-the-minute perspective on leading a change to win the opioid abuse epidemic war and improve care for patients with pain.



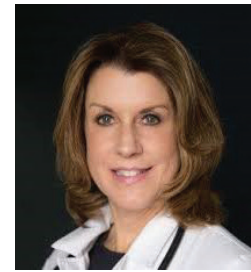

Keynote Speaker - Carolyn Jones, director



Carolyn Jones is a photographer and filmmaker who is passionate about telling stories that shed light on pressing global issues. She has published five books, including "Living Proof: Courage in the Face of AIDS", which became an international traveling exhibition. She also directed a television series for the Oxygen network celebrating women artisans, and founded the "100 People Foundation", a non-profit that creates educational films for students worldwide. Jones spent four years interviewing nurses from all over the country for the photography book and documentary film "The American Nurse", which she hopes will provoke audiences to think differently about their health and healthcare and reflect on the universality of caring for others.

Her latest project Defining Hope is a story about people weighing what matters at the most fragile junctures in life, and the nurses who guide them. It's a documentary that follows patients with life-threatening illnesses as they make choices about how they want to live, how much medical technology they can accept, what they hope for and how that hope evolves when life is threatened. It is optimistic and reminds us that we have choices both in how we die and how we live.
